- Weed Weapon Natural Power works by disrupting the waxy cuticle and cell walls of weed foliage causing rapid uncontrolled water loss, wilting and desiccation.
- Mode of action requires complete coverage of all weeds to ensure that good control is achieved.
- Weed Weapon Natural Power is non-systemic and is rapidly broken down in the soil.
- Fast acting, visible results will happen within hours.

DIRECTIONS

For targeted application on weeds only.

This product is approved for the purposes of spraying of weeds along fence-lines, paths, driveways, adjacent to buildings and yards on any BioGro certified property.

Spraying weeds under or around fruit trees, grape vines or berry canes on BioGro certified properties is also permitted. The applicator must take all practical steps to avoid spray drift on to the crop - we recommend the use of a knapsack sprayer or mini-boom.

Please note this product is not approved for use on crops, spraying of pasture prior to re-sowing and any BioGro certified organic crop destined for organic export markets.

Annual weeds and newly emerged perennial weeds:

Dilute 50 ml Weed Weapon Natural Power per 1 L of water (or 5 L per 100 L of water).

Mature and tougher weeds:

Dilute 100 ml Weed Weapon Natural Power per 1 L of water (or 10 L per 100 L of water).

Application Methods

Knapsack and Gun application: Use conventional application equipment capable of achieving complete coverage of target plants. Use sufficient pressure to penetrate the weed mass so that spray reaches substrate below.

Boom spraying: Apply Weed Weapon Natural Power at rate of 50 - 100 L/ha (using a dilution of 10 L of concentrate per 100 L of water, i.e. 500 - 1000 L water/ha) with course fan nozzles. Boom height should be set so a double overlap of nozzle pattern is achieved at the top of the target plants. Ensure that the coverage penetrates through the canopy of the plant.

For Best Results

- Apply in dry conditions when rain is not expected for 2 hours.
- Complete coverage is required for effective control.
- Best results are achieved on warm dry days and on young weeds.
- For difficult weeds repeat at 3 - 5 days.
- Do not apply to desirable plants or turf as this is a non-selective herbicide.
- If desirable plants are sprayed, immediately hose off with water to minimise harm.
- If using near coloured paving stones or gravel test a sample area before application.
- Avoid spraying aluminum or rubber.
- Apply to weeds <10 cm high.
- Do not apply in temperatures below 3°C.
- Can be used with a spray marker dye.

Precautions: This product must be under the control of an approved or certified handler during use if used in a wide and dispersive manner. Avoid skin contact and inhalation.
